Signature Configuration

One configuration — horizontal and two stand-alone elements icon and tagline — have been approved for general applications.

Stand-Alone Elements

The stand-alone elements — icon and tagline — can be used as long as the All Weather Insulated Panels signature is also incorporated into the piece, whether it's a brochure, a presentation or a web banner.

Always use approved artwork (eps and png files) when reproducing any AWIP signature, icon or tagline. eps Use for quality reproduction, scalable vector art created in Adobe® Illustrator CS5. png Use in Microsoft® Office Suite and Web applications—png files should be scaled at 100% or less. Never enlarge a png file.

Color Palette

The primary colors of AWIP are equal in importance in identifying the company. Precise matching of all AWIP colors is essential in all color applications. Correct and consistent use of colors helps reinforce the identity. It is permissible to use screens, or tints of these colors.

Depending on the medium, colors can be reproduced using one of these formulas:

Pantone: For offset printed materials or signage with match colors, use the Pantone version. The Pantone colors are the same regardless of paper stock specified.

CMYK: For printed materials using the four-color process.

RGB: For Microsoft Office Suite, other computer or broadcast media use.

HEX: For websites and online use.

Clear Zone

The immediate recognition and overall visibility of the AWIP signature can be enhanced by maintaining an ample clear area, void of typography or other elements, around the perimeter. This area is referred to as the "clear zone."

Determining the Clear Zone

Measure the uppercase height of the letter "W" in the AWIP signature (X). A clear zone, represented by the gray field surrounding the identity on all sides, must be equal to or greater than X.

The clear zone applies to all signature configurations — not shown horizontal, centered and stacked configurations.

The clear zone does NOT apply to the tagline.

Correct use of Color

Correct use of color will enhance the impact and reinforce recognition of the AWIP identity: therefore, use of the color palette is always recommended. It is important to maintain a sufficient contrast between the AWIP signature, icon or tagline and the background. Sufficient contrast means that the identity is very easy to read.

Multiple-Color Applications

On a white, light-colored, patterned or photographic background, the AWIP signatures should be reproduced in full color. On medium- or dark-colored, patterned or photographic backgrounds, the AWIP signature must be reproduced in the all-white shown above.

Black & White Applications

The all-black version of the AWIP signature should be used in black & white applications only.
